Do you have a child with complex care needs?

Do you feel like you need extra support?

We are a small team of trained children's carers that help contribute towards a range of care packages for children with complex care needs and disabilities.

We offer short term support to parents/carers and families to provide nursing care in the home and Nursery or school setting, as well as support the implementation of therapies and strategies.

We work alongside the nurses in the Children's Community Nursing team and the Learning Disability Nursing team who plan and monitor all of our work to ensure all therapies are assessed, reviewed and evaluated regularly.

Referral criteria

Your child or young person must have had a nursing assessment completed by a children's community nurse or learning disability nurse. A specific need must be identified through this process for a trained carer to be involved. Please discuss this in more detail with your nurse for more information.

Our role:

- We offer support to parents, families and specifically the child with complex needs
- We help parents access beneficial community services and support groups
- We look after the child in their own home
- We help parents with physiotherapy activities with their child to help progress their development
- We engage in play activities with the child, including general, sensory and therapeutic play
- We can help support you to meet the child's personal hygiene needs
- We give competency based nursing care such as enteral feeding, catheterisation, and suctioning
- We set out agreed plans of action that will support you and your child at a time that is convenient to you, your child and our service
- We work collaboratively with the Children's Community Nursing and learning disability nurses as well as other professionals who work with your child
